stallions – riding horses – mares – foals
eligibility requirements

Stallions

Eligible to submit an application are colts holding Trakehner pedigree papers which are

- a) born in 2017
- b) born in 2015 and 2016, which are additionally required to perform under saddle at the pre-selection as well as the stallion grading (under saddle phase)
- c) born in 2016, with at least one TB or Arabian parent.

Riding horses

The Neumünster Hengstmarkt autumn auction sale offer includes a collection of rigorously selected riding horses. Some of these auction horses are particularly suited for the competitive disciplines dressage and eventing. **As of now**, well-ridden 3- through 10-year-old mares, geldings, and stallions holding Trakehner pedigree papers and with appropriate sport horse condition (stabled, daily training) and age-appropriate training level may apply. The itinerary of the riding horse selection tour will depend on the entries. As the National Trakehner Show in Hanover will definitely serve as a pre-selection site, owners of riding horses applying for preselection are requested to enter their horses at the Hanover horse show as well.

Mares

2- through 8-year-old Trakehner are eligible to submit an application. Two-year-old fillies must be typey, particularly well-developed and with excellent movement. 3- and 4-year-olds must have obtained Verband premium status or else been registered into the studbook with at least 54 points and either have successfully completed mare performance testing or be in foal. The mares may also be presented free-jumping. The 5- to 8-year-old mares must be premium mares registered with at least 54 points and be in foal.

Foals

Applications may be submitted for excellently developed high-quality foals born this year. As the foal will be presented at Neumünster at the foot of its dam, the dam must have undergone proper immunisation as well!

Important pre-selection information

1. Horses presented for pre-selection should be **immaculately groomed and turned out** (hooves, coat) and braided. Clipping the hairs inside the ears and shaving the whiskers is prohibited. When grooming the tail, braiding the dock is not advisable, as this frequently tends to affect the way the tail is carried. Stallions, mares, and riding horses are expected to wear bridles with cavessons with **snaps to attach the reins** to the bit.
2. Handlers are expected to wear black trousers, white shirt and black tie or a white Trakehner polo shirt or sweater.
3. Stallions and mares may be presented with front shoes for pre-selection. Shoes at the hind feet are not permitted. Bear in mind that the shoes must be removed for x-raying.
4. The order of inspection at each site is stallions, mares and foals, riding horses. Optionally, non-pregnant mares may be presented free-jumping.
5. Stallions and mares should stand taller than 160cm (15.3 hands) at preselection.

6. It is advisable for the horse/s to wear **bridle numbers identical to the number in the catalogue** to facilitate quick identification by the interested public.
7. At the preselection site the **horse passport** must be presented (except for foals, where the foal identification form is required).
8. Do submit several alternatives for naming your horse/s. Organizer reserves the right to assign a name to a horse!
9. **Proper vaccination** is essential for all horses presented at a preselection site! This also applies to the dams of the foals presented. Find the vaccination guideline on www.trakehner-verband.de/service/infos-formulare/.
10. The Hengstmarkt admittance fee is 250 EUR per stallion, 200 EUR per mare/ riding horse and 150 EUR per foal.
11. Exhibitor insurance will be effected for all accepted horses; the insurance fee is 119 EUR per stallion, mare, riding horse and 35.70 EUR per foal.
12. All accepted horses must be owned by Trakehner Verband members.
13. Hair samples to carry out doping tests, and, if necessary, parentage verification and genomic selection will be taken from all accepted horses. The exhibitor bears the costs. Numerous random doping tests (hair, blood, urine) will be carried out at the training stable in September and during the Neumünster event.
14. The Trakehner Verband is planning a linear description of all stallions presented for preselection even though this description has no effect on the actual stallion grading.
15. All selected stallions, riding horses and mares require **18 digital radiographs** (front feet left and right: hoof 90° (LM), digit 90° (LM), hoof 0° according to Oxspring (DPrPaDiO) viewing of the fetlock joint space; hind legs left and right: digit 90° (LM), hock 0°(DP), hock 45° (DLPMO), hock 135° (DMPLO) , stifle 90° (LM), stifle 180° (CdPrCrDi)) taken according to the Röntgen Leitfaden (X-Ray Guidelines, 2018) **along with a Radiograph Report Form** issued by the veterinarian taking the x-rays which must be submitted along with the x-rays. No radiographs taken prior to **8 August 2019** will be considered. Poor-quality x-rays or pictures taken prior to the date mentioned above will not be accepted! The exhibitor will be charged for any additional expenses arising from incorrect or late radiographs. Any surgery, for example removal of bone chips, must be stated and documented by **pre-surgery** radiographs. Please compare to the veterinary information on x-rays on our website www.trakehner-verband.de/service.

Label „Trakehner Hengstmarkt“. All radiographs must be submitted by 7 September 2019. Pictures not submitted by the specified time will incur a late fee.
17. The selection panel would like to emphasise that the acceptance of horses on the reserve list may also depend on the x-ray findings.
18. We are trying to **photograph and video** as many of the selected horses as possible for the catalogue and the website. The exhibitor bears the costs.
19. Contact the office to order a **pre-selection catalogue** (3 EUR plus shipping).

The pre-selection entry fee of 50 EUR per stallion, riding horse and mare and 25 EUR per foal is payable for each entry, including no-shows.
